Deadline for submission is Friday, April 21, 2017 to allow for slideshow preparation and judging.

Unless photographers specify otherwise, the winning images will be added to Forestry Images, www.forestryimages.org. Please consider these guidelines as suggested on the Forestry Images website:

- If possible, use at least a 4 megapixel digital camera.
- Images should be taken at the largest size and best quality setting the camera is able to produce.
- Images MUST be at least 700 pixels on the longest side to be used.
- Very good quality can be obtained in high-resolution JPEG files.
- We prefer you send the unedited, least compressed jpeg file available.
- JPEG uses a compression scheme that degrades the image each time it is saved. It is important
  you do everything possible to avoid repeatedly saving the file before submission. If you do edit,
  crop or enhance the JPEG before submitting, be sure to save the image at the highest quality
  possible and try to do all edits at one time to avoid repeatedly saving the file.
